2nd Workout Anytime Headed for Jonesboro

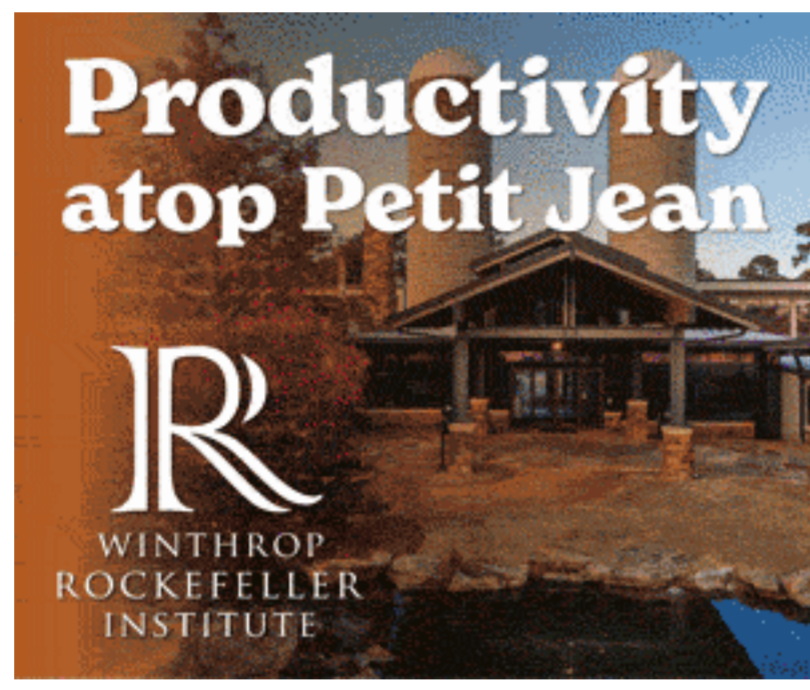
Jonesboro natives Ben Tracy and Wade Quinn plan to open their second Workout Anytime gym in Jonesboro on Sept. 15.

Tracy and Quinn currently own a location with the gym franchise at Hilltop Shoppes. The new gym is at 3106 Southwest Drive.

“The track record with the franchise is strong, as far as their growth pattern and their knowledge of the industry. So that’s what drew us to them specifically. And their price point, too, of course,” Quinn said.

“We kind of got a package deal on them ... we bought two at once,” Tracy added.

The total investment was more than \$1 million, Tracy said, with much of that going for gym equipment. IberiaBank provided financing.



This second gym will open in The Shops at Parker shopping center, formerly Country Mart. Workout Anytime will take up 9,000 SF of the 50,000-SF building. NMcCartney Construction LLC, owned by the duo’s partner Luke McCartney, was contractor for the renovation.
